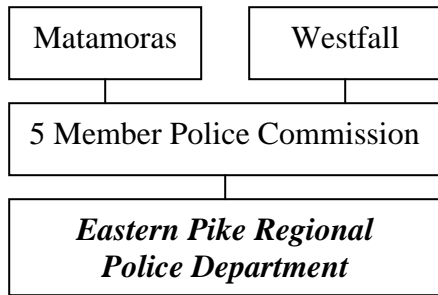


# Department Framework

## HISTORY OF THE DEPARTMENT

The Eastern Pike Regional Police Department includes the Borough of Matamoras, and the Township of Westfall, which are located in the extreme eastern end of Northeastern Pennsylvania. Matamoras Borough occupies 448 acres and has 2,312 residents. Westfall Township occupies 19,456 acres and has 2,430 residents.

The Borough of Matamoras and the Township of Westfall, Pike County, signed a Regionalization agreement on October 4, 2007 to combine their current police forces. On January 7, 2008 the new department started servicing the two communities. This is to be the first regional police department in Pike County.

## HOME SECURITY CHECKS

As a service to our citizens, the Eastern Pike Regional Police Department offers free vacation house checks. The Eastern Pike Regional Police Department will periodically check the exterior of your home while you are away. This service helps to deter potential burglars and provides for additional security while your house is unoccupied.

This service is not recommended for citizens that have friends or family that will be at the residence regularly for such things yard work, caring for animals or using the amenities at the residence.

If you are interested and will be on vacation for at least one week, but not more than two weeks, you may sign up for this service by filling out a security check form at the Police Department.
